## *Milestone Recognition*

For more than ten years, our NGO GReWS has embraced and nurtured those who seek its care with a sole mission – to provide the best of the art and science of health and medicine care GReWS has long advocated for the needs of its communities. Committed to the highest of values it strives to be a place of enduring quality and strength.

He is the active member/coordinator/adviser of many Scientific and Academic organizations. He is the recipient of many awards and honors. He has received a Research fellowship from Thalassaemia International Federation (TIF), Cyprus, and from Christian Medical College, Vellore. He has published more than 61 research papers in National and International journals. He had authored eight books and owned the IPR of his work.

He always helps patients to understand the medical facts, including how heredity contributes to their condition, and the options for dealing with the risk of recurrence.

His support will be key for patients and their families to make decisions and to adjust to a condition. As a genetic expert, he manages his own caseload of patients - through face-to-face interactions, over the phone and via virtual clinics 24\*7 and interprets family and medical histories to calculate the risk of condition occurrence or recurrence. Under his guidance his team arranges genetic tests and medical diagnostic testing of patients as well as testing of relatives.

He always explains their patients in an easy way, to understand language to patients and their relatives about risk and cure also educates them about inheritance patterns, testing, management, prevention, resources and research. He uses his counselling skills to promote and inform patients, adapt to the risk or condition, suggest appropriate screening relating to their condition, deal with psychological and ethical issues raised by individuals and their families. Over a several year he has been keeping patient records and other consultants to ensure appropriate follow-up of patients. He helps the society by facilitating support for Thalassaemia/ Sickle Cell Disorder Tests especially to the needy & poor children.

With the help of his expertise in his field he mentors junior or trainee genetic counsellors and trains them. Using his skills, he has been writing several books on sickle cell & thalassaemia. Through media and social media he also delivered many awareness programmes on doordarshan and other channels.

# Analysis of Microbiome: A Potential Tool For Investigation

The focus objective of forensic sciences is to find clues in a crime scene in order to reconstruct the scenario. The rise of microbiomics and metagenomics has been driven by advances in genomic sequencing technology, improved microbial sampling methods, and fast-evolving approaches in bioinformatics. Humans are a host to diverse microbial communities in and on their bodies, which continuously interact with and alter the surrounding environments. Since information relating to these interactions can be extracted by analyzing human and environmental microbial profiles, they have the potential to be relevant to forensics. Classical samples include DNA or fingerprints, but both have inherent limitations and can be uninformative. Another type of sample has emerged recently in the form of the microbiome. Supported by the Human Microbiome Project, the characteristics of the microbial communities provide real potential in forensics. They are highly specific and can be used to differentiate and classify the originating body site of a human biological trace. Skin microbiota is also highly specific and different between individuals, leading to its possibility as an identification tool. By extension, the possibilities of the microbial communities to be deposited on everyday objects has also been explored. over 100 papers

describing forensic microbiome applications with emphasis on geolocation, personal identification, trace evidence, manner and cause of death, and inference of the postmortem interval (PMI). Other uses include the determination of the post-mortem interval or the analysis of soil communities. One challenge is that the microbiome changes over time and can be influenced by many environmental and lifestyle factors. This review offers an overview of the main methods and applications to demonstrate the benefit of the microbiome to provide forensically relevant information.

Although this field is in its infancy, utilizing microbiome and metagenome signatures has the potential to enhance the forensic toolkit. However, many of the studies suffer from limited sample sizes and model accuracies, and unrealistic environmental settings, leaving the full potential of microbiomics to forensics unexplored. It is unlikely that the information that can currently be elucidated from microbiomics can be used by law enforcement. Nonetheless, the research to overcome these challenges is ongoing, and it is foreseeable that microbiome-based evidence could contribute to forensic investigations in the future

# Dimensional Epidemiology Of Sickle Cell Anaemia (SCA) In India

Sickle-cell anaemia (SCA) is a neglected chronic disorder of increasing global health importance, with India estimated to have the second highest burden of the disease. In the country, SCA is particularly prevalent in scheduled populations, which comprise

the most socioeconomically disadvantaged communities. We compiled a geo-database of a substantial number of SCA surveys carried out in India over the last decade. Using generalized additive models and bootstrapping methods, we generated the first India-specific model-based map of sickle-cell allele frequency which accounts for the district-





level distribution of scheduled and non-scheduled populations. In the view of one research the inclusion of 1.3 million individuals, considerably increased the amount of data in mapping evidence-base studies. Highest predicted frequencies of up to 10% spanned central India, whilst a hotspot of ~12% was observed in Jammu and Kashmir. Evidence was heavily biased towards scheduled populations and remained limited for non-scheduled populations, which can lead to considerable uncertainties in newborn estimates at national and state level. This has important implications for health policy and planning. By taking population composition into account, we have generated maps and estimates that better reflect the complex epidemiology of SCA in India and in turn

provide more reliable estimates of its burden in the vast country.

Both research and action on SCD especially among tribal populations need immediate attention. While geospatial epidemiology has been well understood, gaps remain in context-specific knowledge for action in several parts, as well as evidence gaps across several health system building blocks, including governance and financing of care. Despite publication of a draft policy, delayed adoption and lapses in implementation have limited the response largely to local communities and non-governmental organizations.

**Abstract:** Cigarette smoke and tobacco use is the most important risk factor for lung cancer. Nitrosamine ketones (NNK), Bap (Benzo (a) Pyrenees, NNN (N- nitrosononotobacco are toxic compound causes cancer. The purpose of this study to determine the effect of NNK and Nicotine on ERK and STAT3 signaling in lung cancer cells. NNK, a carcinogen which induces phospho-ERK, STAT3, SGPP1, SphK1 Signaling pathway in lung cancer (L-132) cell Line,

through activation of Janus kinase (JAKs) and Sphingosine -1-phosphate . Janus Kinase (JAKs) and sphingosine -1-phosphate are able to induce cell proliferation, tumor progression and tumor development. However combination treatment of nicotine and NNK didn't induce the signaling pathway. The result of this study showed that NNK is more potent inducer of signaling pathway as compared to nicotine.

# Risk Factors For Tuberculosis Infection In Indian Population

**Abstract:** The risk of progression from exposure to the tuberculosis bacilli to the development of active disease is a two-stage process governed by both exogenous and endogenous risk factors. Exogenous factors play a key role in accentuating the progression from exposure to infection among which the bacillary load in the sputum and the proximity of an individual to an infectious TB case are key factors. Similarly endogenous factors lead in progression from infection to active TB disease. Along with well-established risk factors (such as human immunodeficiency virus (HIV), malnutrition, and young age), emerging variables such as diabetes, indoor air pollution, alcohol, use of immunosuppressive

drugs, and tobacco smoke play a significant role at both the individual and population level. Socioeconomic and behavioural factors are also shown to increase the susceptibility to infection. Specific groups such as health care workers and indigenous population are also at an increased risk of TB infection and disease. Conclusion-TB is a multifactorial disorder, in which environment interacts with host-related factors. This study offered important information for assessing host and environmental determinants of tuberculosis in order to improve TB control actions in developing countries.

In these tough times practicing dentistry was another challenge as any slightest mistake in following norms and protocols or taking precautions can take a toll on health of either dentist or patient.

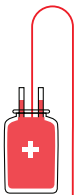
# Banking Sector And Benami Transactions

It's all are like a termite, which is hollowing the economy and security of any nation slowly & slowly and grabbing the entire world in its periphery. Entire world is facing the challenges raised by benami transaction, creation of huge net of benami property and support by certain institutions or group. Even United Nations Organization (UNO) has taken a serious cognizance of these practices and passed a resolution in its convention held in 2003 considering that the effort to counter such evil aspects should not be left as it is, it must be curbed in the interest of the nations' security, enhancing the scope of economy and social prosperity. India being a developing country, the impact of benami transaction has continued to affect in a wider range. In recent past, the Government of India has made many changes in its law regulating the fund flows in line to curb the creation of benami properties and black money flow. Such initiatives include Operation clean money (OCM) policy, Income disclosure Scheme (IDS), demonetization and

implementation of Prohibition of Benami Property Transaction Act, 2016 (PBPT). Demonetization of high value currency notes has attracted large amount of black money in the main stream through banking channels, and Government of India is all set to take on 'benami' properties to check corruption. In the line to operationalize a strong law, Government of India brought 'The Prohibition of Benami Property act 2016' retrospective from 1988 to effectively deal with 'benami' properties. This is seen as a major step to eradicate corruption and black money. But it is of the main concern that still these steps are not adequate to control the corrupt practices through benami transactions.

**Abstract-** DM is a metabolic disorder characterized by the decrease ability or complete inability of the tissues to utilise carbohydrate, accompanied by changes in the metabolism of fat, protein, water & electrolytes.

**Aims & objectives-** The main objective of the present study is to assess the unhealthy habits of diabetic adults, Dietary and other variables that affect how type 2 diabetes is affected by lifestyle.

**Material & Method-** the study was conducted to assess the causes & impact on young type 2 diabetes mellitus. Data for the study was collected by survey method & observation method. Assess the obesity of the sample was collected by using the BMI chart. It has used some educational tools to educate the subjects about diabetes mellitus.

**Result-** During the study it was found that the 36%

subjects strongly agreed to that healthy eating makes a big difference in getting disease .After the second counselling it was found that the subjects follow the diet chart very carefully and do exercise regularly and also follow to SMBG method regularly and their fasting blood glucose level were control and also PPBG level were control.

**Discussion-** From close observation & follow-up during the study period, No consumption of fruits and vegetables in an average day, probably it was the cause of obesity. An Apple and a few veggies a day still keeps the doctor away. The key components of management are weight loss and maintaining a healthy weight, cutting back on calories consumed, and eating a diet high in fruits, vegetables, whole grains, legumes, nuts, and dairy products.

**Summery & conclusion-** Results indicated that there was a marked deficiency in the nutritional level. 50% Diabetic adults were obese as they were consuming more outsider foods and less diet as recommended by ICMR. it was found that the adults understudy were taking less nutrient dense but high energy and unbalance carbohydrate foods when compared to the doses recommended by ICMR, therefore most of them were high blood glucose level. Social issues like illiteracy, poverty, and cultural misconceptions about the role of diet in the management of type II DM might make it challenging for patients to follow a diabetic diet prescription in some cases

Remind them that you are there for them, no matter what, and that you want to hear how they are feeling and what they are thinking. A few simple words of encouragement can help them feel comfortable sharing their feelings with you.

### Work through conflict together

Listen to your teen's views and try to sort out conflict calmly. Remember: everyone gets stressed! Never discuss an issue while you are angry. Walk away, take a breath and calm down, you can talk with your teen about it later. Avoid power struggles. With the world feeling unpredictable and options looking limited right now, teens might be struggling to be in control. As difficult as it can be in the moment, empathize with their desire to assert control in a scary time, rather than attempting to fight back or overpower it. Be honest and transparent with your teen: you can let them know that you are experiencing extra stress as well. Showing them how you deal with your own difficult feelings can help them know their feelings are okay. When there is conflict, take some time to reflect on how you and your teen can resolve it. You can discuss these reflections with your teen, so they see how you are processing ideas.

Trust is a big issue between parents and teens. While teens are allowed to make mistakes and parents should give their teens the ability to earn back their trust.

Parents have the right to make mistakes and change their minds. Mistakes happen, learning to fix a mistake and apologizing is important. No one is perfect and the decision you made may not be the best when you look back on it. It may be time to fall back and regroup. While your teen may not appreciate your reversal right away, your willingness to apologize and correct a mistake is a good to model for them.
